

Summer Tennis Rain Policies

Dear Tennis Participants,

Classes will be re-located to Heritage Tennis Club for inclement weather. All changes to our lesson schedule will be posted on our *Rainout Line*. Instructions are listed below.

- When the weather changes to unfavorable and there is more than 20 minutes of class time left, class will be moved to Heritage Tennis Club. Parents must drive students to the tennis club, instructors will not be able to drive students.
 - a) Once one class moves indoors, the rest of the morning <u>or</u> afternoon classes will also meet indoors. The instructor will not have time to move back outside when classes are scheduled back to back.
 - b) If weather should become a concern, students will be advised not to ride a bike / walk home or to Heritage Tennis Club in bad weather.
 - c) Instructors will not be able to shelter or drive students in their car.
- 2) If there is a severe weather related emergency:
 - a) **Centennial classes may move in to Riley School** if it is before 2:30 pm. After 2:30 pm the gazebo will be a shelter from rain only.
 - b) **Parents must pick up their children** and drive them to Heritage Tennis Club. As soon as all students have been picked up, pro staff will be able to move to Heritage Tennis Club.

Instructors will try to update the status of our classes 15-30 minutes before the scheduled start time. Please know there may be times when the weather will not allow us to update within this time frame.
