

Schaag Park and the Scarsdale Islands
Properties owned and managed by the Arlington Heights Park District

Several larger islands are owned and managed by the Park District while the small islands are owned by the Village of Arlington heights but managed by the Park District. Six islands were acquired in 1940 and are affectionately called, "The Triangles". Ranging from less than .1 of an acre to .75 of an acre, these triangles are tucked in the Scarsdale neighborhood and serve as a passive separation at street intersections. The biggest two parcels are called Schaag Park and consist of a playground for kids under age 5 on the south side of Mayfair and the basketball hoop and open green space to the north side of the Mayfair. One other large parcel is closer to Dryden Elementary School at Fairview-Banbury and Lincoln. Residents have used these larger parcels to host neighborhood gatherings. They are tree lined with off-street parking.
