

Pool/ Pool Deck rules

No running, pushing, horseplay, etc.

No glass containers, food, or non-water beverages.

Observe all posted rules and directions from aquatics staff.

Children ages eight and younger must be supervised by an adult in each pool area at 1:5 adult to child ratio.

Anyone requiring a life vest or flotation device must be supervised by an adult at a 1:1 ratio with the adult in the water.

Small water toys like squish balls and diving sticks are allowed. Larger items like pool floats, noodles, and water blasters are prohibited.

Outdoor rental packages during open swim do NOT include reserved space on pool decks or in grassy or concessions areas.

Alcohol, tobacco, and vaping items are not allowed in buildings and pool areas.

Party Room rules for room rentals during open swim

All party attendees 2+ years, must wear a wristband to access the party room and pool decks and may not enter the pool area until the start of the reservation.

An adult with the rental party is responsible for greeting guests at the facility entrance and distributing wristbands.

Renters may access the room 30 minutes prior to the reservation for party set up and will have access to the room for 20 minutes after the party for clean-up.

Party room set up includes seating for 32 people and two additional serving tables. All tables and chairs must remain in the party room.

An adult with the rental party must supervise the party room any time children are in the room.

All guests must remain in either the party room or pool area during the rental. Rentals do not include access to other areas of the facility (track, gym, fitness areas, etc.)

Decorations:

- Decorations are allowed in the party room, but not in the pool area.
- Items that are difficult to hang or clean up including, but not limited to, confetti, glitter, rice, powders and piñatas are NOT allowed.
- Renter is responsible for cleaning all decorations, food, and trash and disposing of them in trash receptacles.
