

WELCOME TO THE ARLINGTON HEIGHTS PARK DISTRICT SKATE PARK.

We want you to have a fun and safe time, be courteous and respectful to others and keep the skate park clean. For your safety and enjoyment, we ask that you observe the following statements/rules.

- **Skateboarding is a recreational activity with inherent risks of serious injury.**
- **This skate park is unsupervised. Use at your own risk.**
- **Be aware of other skateboarders and always watch for oncoming skaters.**
- **The skate park is CLOSED during Park District programs, after sunset, during inclement weather, and/or when equipment is damaged or wet.**
- **Do not use this facility if a hazardous condition exists, including rain, snow, ice and darkness.**
- **Skaters are responsible for inspecting the equipment prior to use to ensure it has not been vandalized and is safe for skating. Do not use the equipment if broken or wet.**
- **Proper protective equipment including helmets, elbow pads, knee pads, etc. are required.**
- **Shirt, pants, and shoes are required at all times.**
- **Children under 9 years should be accompanied by a responsible person age 14 or older.**
- **The Park District is not responsible for lost or stolen items.**
- **All users must follow the Arlington Heights Park District Behavior Code of Conduct.**
- **All organized events must have written approval from the Arlington Heights Park District.**
- **No contests or demos without the permission of the Park District.**

The following items are prohibited:

- **Personally owned ramps, boxes or other devices**
- **Glass objects and containers in skating area**
- **Profanity and loud music**
- **Food, beverages, gum, weapons, and smoking or vaping within the skate park area**
- **Pets**
- **Motorized wheels, bicycles & scooters**
- **Skating after dark**
