

# PICKLEBALL COURT RULES

We want you to have a fun and safe time, be courteous and respectful to others. For your safety and enjoyment, we ask that you observe the following rules:

## SAFETY:

- Proper footwear is required. All participants must wear soft soled shoes.
- Hanging on nets is prohibited.
- Dogs are prohibited on courts.
- Glass containers are prohibited on or near courts.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on Park District property.

## COURT USAGE AND ETIQUETTE:

- Warning: Use courts at your own risk.
- Arlington Heights Park District lessons and permit holders take priority.
- Courts are for pickleball only. Inline skating, bicycling, skateboarding, etc. are not allowed on the pickleball courts.
- Play on all courts begins and ends on the hour.
- Limit consecutive play when others are waiting.
- Play doubles when courts are full.

## GENERAL RULES:

- Players are required to observe pickleball courtesies and good sportsmanship at all times.
- Court schedules are contingent upon weather conditions.
- Snow removal is prohibited.
- Pickleball courts open from 8AM to dark, unless otherwise posted or authorized by the Arlington Heights Park District.
- No coaching, instructing, training, etc. for compensation, reference Ordinance 260, Section 30 for more information.

## PADDLE UP:

- Please observe the posted drop-in paddle up play times at specific locations.
- Paddle up play allows for larger groups to rotate through courts, with minimal down time.
- Outside of the posted paddle up play times, when others are waiting, players may not play two consecutive hours.
- Players may only paddle up one court at a time.
- Players may not re-paddle up a court until all players waiting are done.
