



Arlington Heights Park District Behavior Code of Conduct

The Arlington Heights Park District is committed to providing an enjoyable, exciting and satisfying recreational experience in well-maintained facilities for our residents and guests. Participants and spectators are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior and be respectful of others at all times when using Park District parks and facilities. The Park District has adopted the following guidelines.

All participants and spectators shall:

- Show respect to all participants, staff, volunteers, and spectators
- Follow program rules and take direction from instructors or Park District team members
- Refrain from using abusive or foul language, arguing, fighting, behaving in a violent or threatening manner or any other form of harassment or intimidation
- Refrain from causing bodily harm to other participants, staff, volunteers, and spectators
- Not use Park District programs or services without paying the designated fees
- Follow all safety rules and guidelines
- Not possess or use illegal chemicals or alcohol on Park District property without proper permits
- Show respect for equipment, supplies and facilities
- Refrain from bringing weapons or devices that may be used as a weapon onto Park District property or into its programs
- Report any inappropriate, unsafe or illegal conduct to Park District team members or the Police
- Dress appropriately

Additional rules may be developed for specific programs and leagues as deemed necessary.

To ensure the Park District's programs and facilities remain safe and enjoyable, all reported incidents will be investigated on a case-by-case basis. Violation of this Code of Conduct or inappropriate behavior may result in loss of privileges in accordance with the Behavior Management Procedure.
