PUBLIC HEARING

Bond Issuance Notification Act

President Leno stated at this time she will open the Bond Issuance Notification Act Hearing to receive any comments relative to the District's proposal to sell not to exceed \$15,000,000 in General Obligation Limited Park Bonds for park purposes and projects, for the payment of outstanding obligations of the District and for payment of the expenses incident thereto.

President Leno stated all persons desiring to be heard on this matter will now have an opportunity to present written or oral testimony to the Board of Commissioners. No person presented written or oral testimony to the Board of Commissioners.

President Leno stated these proposed bonds are to be issued for the payment of land condemned or purchased for parks, for the building, maintaining, improving and protecting of the same and the existing land and facilities of the District, for the payment of outstanding obligations of the District and for the payment of the expenses incident thereto.

President Leno asked, before any testimony from the public, if any Board of Commissioners member would like to make comment regarding the proposal to issue General Obligation Limited Park Bonds? No Commissioner made any comments.

President Leno asked if any residents or members of the public here this evening wish to provide oral or written testimony concerning the proposed issuance of the General Obligation Limited Park Bonds. No one came forward.

President Leno then asked Executive Director Fullerton if the District received any written or other type of correspondence regarding the proposed issuance of the General Obligation Limited Park Bonds? Executive Director Fullerton responded none were received.

With all persons desiring to be heard had been given an opportunity to present oral and written testimony regarding the proposal to issue the Bonds, President Leno entertained a motion to adjourn the Hearing.


