Governed

By a five member, volunteer Board of Commissioners, each of whom serves four years. Current Board consists of Maryfran H. Leno, President; Timothy A. Gelinis, Vice President; Brian Owen; Robert Nesvacil and John Supplitt.

Boundaries

The 16.2-square mile District is located in northern Cook County and southern Lake County, 27 miles northwest of downtown Chicago. It lies in Elk Grove and Wheeling Townships and is bordered by Buffalo Grove and Wheeling to the north; Elk Grove Village on the south; on the west by Rolling Meadows and Palatine; on the east by Mt. Prospect. The District serves most of Arlington Heights and small portions of Palatine, Mt. Prospect, Prospect Heights, Rolling Meadows, and Lake County.

Staff

The District has an appointed executive director responsible for administration of the District and 95 authorized full-time staff. The District also employs over 1,100 part-time, seasonal, and temporary workers, and volunteers.

Fiscal Year Budget

The proposed operating budget for 2026/27 is \$31,865,490 prior to \$3,055,930 of interfund transfers with an additional \$12,719,460 in capital spending. The fiscal year begins May 1 and concludes on April 30.

How to Get Information

Applicable Fees

- No fee shall be charged for the first fifty (50) pages of black and white, letter, or legal sized copies.
- Fees for copies of public records that exceed fifty pages, in a particular instance, on letter or legal size paper, shall be calculated at the rate of 15 cents per page. If the requestor asks that copies of the public records be sent to the requestor, postal or express mail charges shall be assessed at the actual cost incurred by the Park District.
- Fees for copies of public records that are in color, or in a size other than letter or legal, shall be assessed at the actual cost of reproduction.
- The fees established above shall not apply to electronic copies of records. In each instance the Park District shall charge the requestor for the actual cost of purchasing the recording medium for electronic copies.

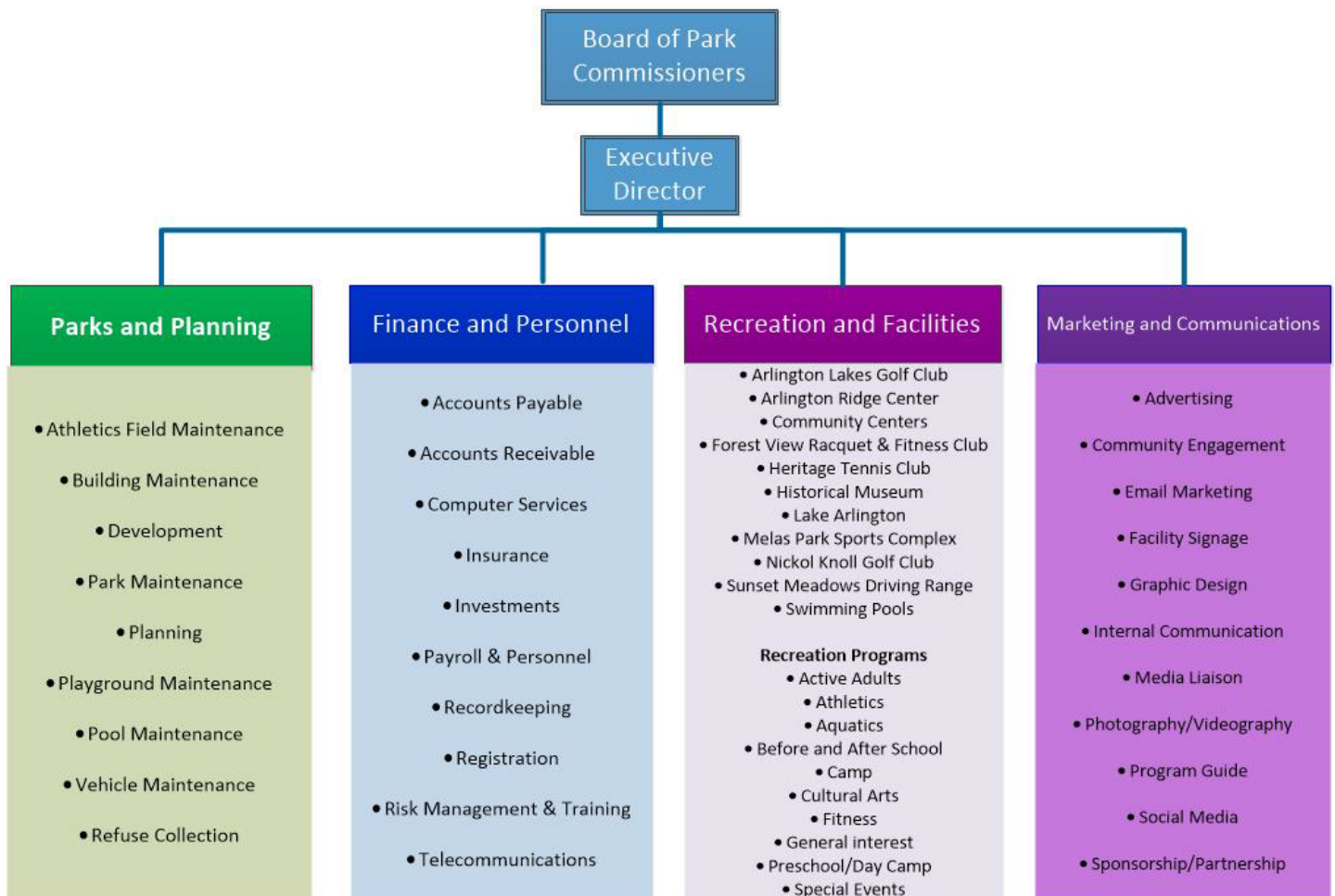
